(a) & (b) No, Sir. There is no unhealthy competition from Tamil Nadu State operated bus transport. Tamil Nadu State Government is giving all assistance for development of inter-model system. Bus terminal has been developed in Chintadripet Station. Further action is on hand to develop bus terminals at Triplicane and Thirumailai after vacating the hutments in this area. In Phase II of MRTS, all stations are proposed to be developed with space for bus terminal.
