Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the process of export of aromatic Basmati rice could not be taken up in the schedule time and is delayed for about two months;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the estimated quantum of Basmati rice likely to be exported during this season; and
- (d) the steps being taken by the Government to find the market for Indian Basmati rice?

Answer

MINISTER OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRI MURASOLI MARAN)

- (a) No, Sir.
- (b) Does not arise.
- (c) It is not possible to estimate the likely quantum of basmati rice exports, as export of basmati rice would depend upon international demand and supply position, domestic demand and supply position, international and domestic prices, consumer preferences and varieties traded.
