(a) Yes, Sir. The Union Government has approved launching of two more satellites to boost the telecommunications, TV Broadcasting and Very Small Aperture Terminal (VSAT) services network of the country.

(c) This is a part of the on-going need to build enough C, Ext-C & Ku-band capacity in the INSAT system as per the approved 9th Plan programme.
