- (a) whether revival schemes of Jessop, Braithwaite and Burn Standard are not taking off due to inadequate orders for Wagons;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government to ensure adequate wagon orders to these Public Sector Undertakings?

(a) & (b): The revival schemes of Jessop, Braithwaite & Burn Standard are not progressing as expected on account of lack of wagon orders and for other products, low productivity, surplus manpower, etc. Wagon orders available with these PSUs are less than targeted as per details below:

Jessop & Company Limited	1800.0	420.0
Braithwaite & Company Limited	3075.0	2520.0

(c): The Ministry is continuously taking up the issue of placement of adequate wagon orders on these PSUs with the Railways.
