- (a) The production of textiles i.e. textile yarn and fabrics since 1991-92 has grown at an annual compound rate of 10.6 per cent and 6.7 per cent respectively to meet the growing demand, apart from exports.
- (b) The Union Government acts as a facilitator for the setting up of textile mills in the country within the frame-work of Government Policy.
