(a) the steps taken to complete construction work of National Highway-80 from Mokama to Farakka;

(b) the progress made in the construction work during the current financial year;

(c) whether alignment of this National Highway in West Bengal portion has been finalised; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

(a)&(b) Development and maintenance of National Highways is a continuous process and is undertaken depending upon the intensity of traffic, inter-se priority on all India basis and availability of funds etc. 15 numbers of works amounting to Rs 1316.41 lakh have been approved and funds are allocated for the purpose. The state government has been directed to complete these works at the earliest. Two works amounting to Rs. 109.78 lakh have since been completed.

(c)&(d) No, Sir. Survey and investigation of the alignment is in progress.
