(a) & (b): The area of mines covered by the Mahanadi Coalfields Limited is 21523.96 hectares. The area of public/private/Government land acquired by Mahanadi Coalfields Limited in Orissa till date is given as under:-

1. Private/Tenancy land - 3481.84 hectares

(i) Government non-forest land - 3666.27 hectares

- + Physical possession of only 42.42 hectares has been handed over to MCL.
- (c) & (d) : Yes, Sir. Employment has been provided in respect of 5063 land loosers upto September, 2000. An amount of Rs.9.64 crores has also been incurred by the company for development of the rehabilitation sites and payment of one time cash grant in lieu of resettlement plots.
