(a) & (b): Mahboobnagar was one of the pilot districts identified by the Government of Andhra Pradesh for implementing sector reform projects which aims to institutionalise community participation in Rural Water Supply Programme. Subsequently, Government of Andhra Pradesh revised the list of pilot districts and Mahboobnagar is not one among them. Consequently the project proposal for rural water supply in respect of Mahboobnagar submitted earlier is not being considered for sanction.

No Total Sanitation Campaign project proposal has, however, been received from Mahboobnagar.
