- (a) the categories considered by the Railway Authorities for allotment of tea stalls, fruit stalls, medical stores and the PCO/STD booths, on railway stations;

(a) Allotment of catering/vending stalls including Medical Stores by inviting applications from reputed and expressed professionals through press notification. Catering policy provides for reservation for SC/ST categories. However, in case of PCO/STD booths, a reservation has been provided for physically handicapped persons, ladies and unemployed youths including SC/ST/OBC categories.
