- (a) the details of Doordarshan relay centres set up in Karnataka and Maharashtra during the last three years, location-wise;
- (b) the amount spent thereon, separately, in each State; and
- (c) the estimated amount spent normally on setting up of a single Doordarshan relay centre at any place ?

(a) & (b): Location-wise details of the transmitters set up in Karnataka and Maharashtra, in the last three years, with the amount spent thereon separately, is given in the Annexure.

(c): Approximate capital cost for establishment of a High Power TV Transmitter is about Rs.8.00 crores and that for a Low Power Transmitter is about Rs.1.00 crore.
