(d) if so, the amount of financial concession extended to them during the above period?

## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRI OMAR ABDULLAH)

(a) The Ministry is not maintaining State-wise details of export-import turn over.

(b) Export Oriented Units (EOUs) earned foreign exchange of Rs. 12058.27 crores during1998-99 and Rs. 14000 crores (Provisional) during 1999-2000.

(c) & (d) EOUs are entitled for duty free import / local purchase ofmachinery, raw material , components and consumables etc. required for export production and refund of Central Sales Tax paid on the purchases made from domestic market. These units also enjoy corporate tax holiday for a maximum period of 10 years. These benefits cannot be quantified in financial terms.
