(d) if so, the details thereof;

(e) the funds allocated and spent by the Government for the repair and maintenance work of this National Highway during last three years and till date;

(f) whether the Government propose to get it repaired through a Central agency; and (g) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b) National Highway-31 is being maintained generally in traffic worthy condition within available resources.

(c) & (d) Bihar Road Construction Department has been advised to undertake investigations in consultation with State Irrigation Department and Railways to formulate proposals for protective work for National Highway from Maheshkunt to Gerabari.

(e) Allocations for maintenance and repairs are made State-wise and not National Highway-wise. During last three years, funds as under were allocated to the concerned States for maintenance/repairs of National Highways including National Highway-31:
