Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Dr. Ambedkar Birth Centenary Celebrations Committee recommended to fill the backlog of vacancies reserved for the SCs/STs in the year 1993;
- (b) if so, the action taken thereon since 1993 by his Ministry in respect of backlog vacancies concerning his Ministry and the result thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons for;
- (d) the number of vacancies reserved for SCs/STs which remain unfilled as on January 1, 1993 in Class I, II, III and IV category under his Ministry and action taken to fill these vacancies; and
- (e) the backlog of vacancies reserved for the SCs/STs in Class I, II, III and IV categories as on August 29, 1997?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (DR. RAMAN SINGH)

- (a) to (c) Sir, Dr. Ambedkar Birth Centenary Celebration Committee has recommended that in situations where backlog vacancies reserved for SCs/STs are more in number and adequate number of candidates from the reserved communities with the prescribed qualifications are not available, minimum qualifications may be relaxed. However, the Department of Personnel and Training, nodal Department for reservation in services for SCs & STs have observed that it would not be possible to give relaxation in the basic academic qualification/minimum qualification as it would be against the spirit of Art. 335 of the Constitution.
- (d) The number of vacancies reserved for SCs/STs which remained unfilled as on January 1, 1993in Class I, II,III and IV is as per statement at Annexure-I.
- (e) The number of backlog vacancies reserved for SCs/STs in Class I, II, III, and IV categories as on August 29, 1997s as per statement at Annexure-II.
