Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government are aware of population growth in India which is increasing rapidly in comparison with last decade;
- (b) if so, the detailed position in respect of minorities and reasons for their rapid growth; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government to check the population growth?

Answer

- (a) The growth rate of population during 1981-91 as observed in 1991 census has declined to 2.14% per annum from 2.22% during 1971-81 as observed in 1981 census. The natural growth rate of population (birth rate minus death rate) during 1998 is 1.74% as per the estimates of Sample Registration System (SRS) by Registrar General, India.
- (b) Does not arise.
- (c) Following actions are being taken by the Government to check the population growth:
- (i) Propagation of Family planning methods which include sterilisation both for male and female, spacing methods namely, IUD insertions, oral pills and condoms;
- (ii) Fulfillment of unmet needs of contraceptives through provision of integrated service delivery at village level:
- (iii) Information, Education and Communication Programme to create awareness about the benefits of small family:
- (iv) Provision of additional inputs in weaker States/districts
