CLOSURES OF INDUSTRIES

Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) The details of newly set up and closed down industries during the last three years, State-wise;
- (b) the reasons therefor and the extent to which the Government policies have been responsible for closure of these industries; and
- (c) the number of employees rendered jobless due to closure of these industries?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY(DR. RAMAN SINGH)

(a) to (c) : 205 Industrial Licenses have been granted and 1207 Industrial Entrepreneurs Memoranda (IEMs) have been implemented during the last three years i.e., from 1997 to 1999. Closure of 441 industrial units has been reported from 1997 to 1999. State-wise details are at annexures I and II. As a result of closure of 441 industrial units, 38,577 workers have been affected.

Labour Bureau, Shimla, under the Ministry of Labour collects information on closure and reasons therefor. According to the Bureau, the main reasons for closing down of industries were financial stringency, shortage of power, lack of demand for products, shortage of raw material and break-down of machinery.
