Some of the major steps taken in this regard include installation of Automatic Mail Processing Centres at Chennai and Mumbai, computerisation of registration sorting work, segmentation of mail into different channels for quicker segregation and speedy delivery, sustained monitoring of mail routing and delivery by managerial cadres and providing mopeds to postmen wherever feasible to facilitate quicker delivery of mails.
