MINISTER OF TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SHRI JUAL ORAM)

(a) Under the scheme, fund is not released for the development of tribal areas. However, financial assistance to the tune of 90% is released to NGOs in Manipur for taking up projects like Residential School, Mobile Dispensary, 10-bedded hospital etc., for welfare of tribals. The amount released during the last three years is as under:-
