(a) to (c): The Governmet has, in partial modification of the previous decision in the matter of disinvestment of Indian Petrochemicals Corporation Limited (IPCL), decided that the Vadodara plant of IPCL, which has synergies with Gujarat Refinery of Indian Oi Corporation Limited, may, after proper valuation, be transferred to the Indian Oil Corporation Limited. The rest of IPCL may, as decided earlier, be disinvested through strategic sale of 25% equity.
