- (a) the number of A-320 aircraft with the Government at present;
- (b) whether the Government have a proposal to increase its A-320 fleet;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the time by which the new airbuses are expected to be acquired; and
- (e) the steps so far taken in this direction?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI SHARAD YADAV)

- (a): There are 30 A-320 aircraft in the fleet of Indian Airlines.
- (b) and (c): Indian Airlines is in the process of acquiring 2 A-320 aircraft on dry lease basis. These aircraft are likely to be delivered shortly.
- (d) and (e): A Techno Economic evaluation study by Indian Airlines Limited to augment its fleet capacity and to replace the ageing fleet of the existing Aircraft is currently underway.
