- (a) & (b) The post-earthquake satellite imagery of 29 January, 2001 of the area around Udai village and Pachchamm Islandindicates the possibility of number of sub-surface stream channels in Rann of Kutch which temporarily developed during the earthquake.
- (c) to (e) No assessment of the quantity of water flowing at present in these stream channels has been made.
