(a)&(b) Yes, Sir. The Government has approved the expansion of the ongoing World Bank assisted 8th India Population Project (IPP-VIII) currently under implementation in the cities of Bangalore, Calcutta, Delhi and Hyderabad to 94 additional cities/towns in the States of Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka and West Bengal.Besides, Uttar Pradesh and Tamil Nadu have also been covered for improvement of the logistic facilities.

(c)to(e) The total cost of the project has been revised from Rs.223.37 crore to Rs.422.01 crore and the project period extended from 6.8.1998 to 30th June, 2001. No other World Bank aided project is being expanded at present.

(f) The state-wise population covered under the revised IPP-VIII project is as under.
