- (d) if so, the results thereof and if not, reasons therefor?

(a) to (d) : On receipt of a reference from Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) in this connection, Government had ordered an enquiry by a retired Joint Secretary into the irregularities allegedly committed in the award of work regarding recruitment of teachers in Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan to EDCIL. The enquiry officer has submitted his report and the same is under examination in consultation with CVC.
