(a) the number of Inspectors belonging to the parent cadre and on deputation working in the Central Bureau of Investigation (C.B.I.) at present; and

(b) the academic qualifications of present Inspectors and the qualification prescribed for the post of Inspectors?

(a): There are 637 inspectors working in the CBI, out of which 343 belong to the CBI cadre and 294 are on deputation from other organisations.

(b): Out of 637 Inspectors presently working in the CBI 121 are post-graduates, 396 graduates and 120 under-graduates. The posts of Inspector in the CBI are filled either by promotion or by deputation/transfer. As such no minimum educational qualification is prescribed in the Recruitment Rules for the post of Inspector.
