(a) &(b) No, Sir. There was an approved outlay of Rs.327.50 crores for implementation of Plan Schemes of Medical & Public Health Sector of various agencies under the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi during Annual Plan 2000-2001 Against this outlay, an amount of Rs.266.14 crores had been kept in Revised Estimate (R.E.) for 2000-2001.For the year 2001-2002, an outlay of Rs.341.21 crores has been approved representing an increase of 28% over the provisions of R.E. for 2000-2001.
