(a), (b), (c) & (d): In his Budget Speech for 2001-2002, the Finance Minister had announced constitution of a High Level Expert Group to review the existing pension scheme and to provide a roadmap for devising a new pension system based on defined contributions in respect of those who enter Central Government service after 1st October, 2001. The Group is to give its recommendations within three months. Action to constitute the Expert Group has been initiated.
