- (a) whether Integrated Infrastructural Development (IID) scheme to promote stronger linkages between agriculture and industry was launched in 1994:
- (b) if so, the areas which are covered under this scheme;
- (c) whether proposals for this scheme are routed through State Government after project appraisal from SIDBI;
- (d) if so, the total number of schemes submitted by Andhra Pradesh to Union Government during the last three years and cleared by Union Government;
- (e) the number of projects pending with Union Government; and
- (f) the time by which these are likely to be cleared?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES AND AGE RURAL INDUSTRIES (SMT. VASUNDHARA RAJE)

- (a): Yes, Sir.
- (b): The Scheme covers the entire country with 50% reservation for rural areas.
- (c): Under the Scheme, the State Governments/Union Territories are required to firm up the proposals and submit these to Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) for techno-economic appraisalSIDBI submits the appraisal reports to Central Government for consideration.
- (d): During the last three years Government of Andhra Pradesh submitted four proposals under the Scheme and all of them have been cleared.
- (e): None.
- (f): Does not arise.
