(a) & (b) : Biotech industry is flourishing globally and is expected to be a major generator of wealth. In India several programmes are under implementation. New institutional structures like biotech parks, incubation centres and research institutions are proposed to be established during the tenth plan. Research on new drugs, drug delivery systems, vaccines, diagnostics and recombinant products is a continuing activitity. Forty technologies supported by DBT have been given to industry for commercialization. Many more are in the pipe line as envisaged in the tenth plan.
