- (b) if so, the details thereof and the quantity of foodgrains so far supplied to the States?

(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. The Government authorised the Food Corporation of India on 16.01.2001 to release damaged (feed category foodgrains), free of cost, to the drought affected States of Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Orissa, Rajasthan and Uttaranchal. As on 19.04.2001, the following quantities of damaged foodgrains have been lifted by the following States:
