- (b) Business Development Directorate was set up in 1996 to design, develop and market value-added premium products of the Department of Posts. The responsibilities of the Business Development Directorate are enumerated as follows:

Expansion and promotion of the existing value-added products and services.

Designing & launching of new value-added products and services;

Set up procedures, regulations and guidelines for their retailing and networking;

Market study, market testing and products improvement.

Training for personnel;

Monitoring and reviewing of growth of value-added products and services.
