- (a) whether there is shortage optical fibre in the country; and
- (b) if so, the steps taken by the Government to meet the present requirement in this regard?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI TAPAN SIKDAR)

- (a) Yes Sir, there is shortage of optical fibre cable due to non acceptance of tendered prices by various vendors against 24F/12F optical fibre cable tendered during 2000-2001. Against the requirement of one lakh km of optical fibre cable availability is only approximately 58,000 km.
- (b) Fresh global tender and local tenders have been called to procure additional cable required for the year 2001-2002 and balance cable of year 2000-2001.
