- (a) whether the Government propose to expand the capacity of the Barauni Refinery;
- (b) if so, the total investment likely to be made for the purpose;
- (c) the details of contracts finalised in this regard; and
- (d) the time by which expansion of the refinery is likely to be completed?

- (a) &(b): Indian Oil Corporation Limited, propose to expand the capacity of Barauni Refinery from 4.2 to 6 Million Metric Tonnes Per Annum at a cost of Rs.1803 crore.
- (c) The project is being executed on Lumpsum Turnkey (LSTK) basis.It has been divided in four LSTK contracts out of which 3 have been finalised and the fourth is under finalisation.
- (d) The project is scheduled to be mechanically completed by February, 2002.
