- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI SHRIPAD Y. NAIK)

(a)&(b): The National Agricultural Insurance Scheme (NAIS) has already beenimplemented in the country from Rabi 1999-2000 season. Scheme has been extended to all States/UTs. However, so far only the following 18 States/UTs have implemented the scheme:-

- 1. Andhra Pradesh 2. Assam
- Bihar
 Goa
 Gujarat
 Himachal Pradesh
 Karnataka
 Kerala
- 8. Maharashtra 10. Madhya Pradesh 11. Meghalaya 12. Orissa 13. Sikkim 14. Tamil Nadu

- 15. Uttar Pradesh 16. West Bengal
- 17. Pondicherry 18. Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

(c): The scheme is available to all the States/UTs. It is, however, at the discretion of the States/UTs to implement the scheme or not. Consent/options from all the States/UTs were called for. Only 18 States/UTs have come forward to implement the scheme.
