THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI TAPAN SIKDAR)

- (a) No, Sir. However, in the last three months, four complaints of excess billing have been received.

- (c) Such complaints are examined and rebate is granted in genuine cases where technical faults etc. are found.
