(b),(c)&(d) The proposals for disinvestment in PSUs are processed as per prescribed procedures, which involve inter-ministerial consultations at various levels. Such proposals are at different stages of consideration in the Department of Disinvestment and concerned Administrative Ministries. There is no delay in processing these cases.
