THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SMT. SUSHMA SWARAJ)

- (a) On the basis of an agreement signed between Ministry of I&B andIGNOU, the Government has given permission to IGNOU for operating FM Educational channel in 40 centres. At present, there is no plan for starting a National Testing Service.
- (b) The details of total outlay for the project are being obtained.
- (c): As per the agreement, It should be commissioned within 3 years from the date of frequency allocation.
- (d): The Gyan Vani FM channel will be covering 4 metro cities and 36centres and will cover a wide network of distant learners and hitherto unreached population of the country.
