Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the airport at Bareilly is functional for civilian aircraft;
- (b) if so, the annual maintenance cost of that airport;
- (c) whether there is any proposal to connect Bareilly or Moradabad with flights to and fro from Delhi and Lucknow;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI SHARAD YADAV)

- (a) and (b):- No, Sir. The airport at Bareilly which belongs to Indian Air Force does not have facilities for operation of civilian aircraft.
- (c), (d) and (e):- Private operators/State Government have plans to operate limited number of civil flights from Bareilly and preparation of modalities for operation of civil flights is at a preliminary stage. There is no airport at Moradabad.
