- (c) the time by which the Committee is likely to submit its report?

## **Answer**

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) The Committee, comprising of representatives from government and private sectors and Telecom Regulatory Authority of India, has been established to review the National Frequency Allocation Plan (NFAP)-2000. Proposals have been invited from all interested entities in the government and private sectors for consideration by the Committee to review NFAP-2000 in line with Radio Regulations of the International Telecommunication Union.
- (c) The Committee is likely to submit its report in October 2001.
