Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any project to recharge the water level in Gujarat has been submitted to the Union Government;
- (b) if so, the present status of the project;
- (c) the main objectives of the project;
- (d) whether the project is proposed to be implemented in other States;
- (e) if so, whether the Government have mobilised any additional financial resources for the implementation of the project; and
- (f) if so, the time by which the project is likely to be cleared?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SMT. BIJOYA CHAKRAVARTY)

- (a) to (c) Government of Gujarathave submitted following two projects having ground water recharge component for financial assistance:-
- (i) "Augmentation of Surface Water Recharge in Over- exploited Aquifers (Gujarat)" at an estimated cost of Rs. 305.64 crore. The Project envisages construction of minor irrigation works like check dams, percolation tanks, underground check dams, spreading channel, feeding village tanks, recharge wells, injection wells in rivers, deepening of villages tanks, conjunctive use of ground water in Dharoi Canal Command Area, afforestation and soil water conservation works. The proposal has been sent to the Royal Netherlands Embassy through the Department of Economic Affairs on 05.02.2001 for financial Assistance. Reactions of the Government of Netherlands are awaited.
- (ii) "Gujarat Salinity PreventionProject" at an estimated cost of Rs. 1160.00 crore. The project aims to tackle the problem of salinity ingress by taking three fold measures i.e. improving management, increasing recharge and controlling the salinity. The project was sent to the World Bank through the Department of Economic Affairs on 14.06.2000 for financial assistance. Reactions of the World Bank are awaited.
- (d) to (f) The Central Ground Water Board under the Ministry of Water Resources have carried out ground water recharge experiments and rain water harvesting on pilot basis in various States of the country under its Central Sector Scheme on "Studies on Artificial Recharge of Ground Water". The Government have earmarked funds amounting to Rs. 25.00crore for the scheme during the IX Five Year Plan. State-wise details of the proposals approved under the scheme are given in the enclosed Statement. The approved proposals are expected to be implemented within 1-2 years.
