- (a) the number of blood sample scrued till December 31, 1999 in India and the number out of them were found HIV positive;
- (b) the efforts made to check the spread of HIV in the country;
- (c) the reasons for increase in HIV cases;
- (d) whether Manipur has the highest percentage of HIV positive population; and
- (e) if so, the details of the population declared HIV positive and the comparative figures of the States in this regard vis-…-vis other North Eastern States of the country?

- (a) As on 31st December, 1999, the number of persons screened is 3572144 and out of them 92312 were found HIV positive.
- (b) In order to prevent and control the spread of HIV/AIDSin India, a comprehensive Programme is currently under implementation throughout the country as a centrally sponsored scheme. The main components consist of :- ðReducing the spread of HIV ingroups at high risk by identification of target populations and providing peer counseling, condom promotion, treatment of sexually transmitted infections. ðPreventive intervention for the general population by Information, Education and Communication(IEC) and awareness campaign, provision of voluntary testing and counseling, safe blood transfusion services and prevention of occupational exposure. ðProviding financial assistance for opportunistic infections, home and community based care. ðStrengthening effectiveness and technical, managerial, financial sustainability at National, State and Municipal levels.
- (c) HIV infected persons remains asymptomatic for 5-7 years during which he spreads the infection. Besides, there is no cure for HIV/AIDS, which can eliminate the infection from the body of the infected person.
- (d) Yes, Sir. Manipur is one of the States with highest percent of HIV infection.
- (e) The number of persons declared positive for HIV in the state of Manipuris 63257 as on 31st March, 2000. The comparative figures of the states in this regard vis-a-vis other Northern States of the country is annexed.
