(d) During the balance period of the 9th Plan period, SCI has plans toacquire/place order for 1 (one) Very Large Crude Carrier (VLCC), 2 (two) LR-II size tankers, 2 (two) Capesize bulk carriers, 2 (two) acid/chemical carriers apart from the tonnage already on order.
