- (d) whether an enquiry has been conducted in this regard;
- (e) if so, the outcome thereof; and
- (f) the steps taken by the Government to punish the guilty doctors?

(a)&(b): Yes, Sir. The news items captioned `Doctors in the dock` pertains to All India Institute of Medical Sciences, G.B. Pant Hospital and Delhi Medical Council. The facts are being collected and will be laid on the table of the House. The news-item captioned `negligence caused abortion death` appearing in the Indian Express dated March 14, 2000 deals with the post-mortem report of the deceased Monita Bhardwaj who died in Safdarjung Hospital on 10/3/2000. The post-mortem was conducted outside Safdarjung Hoxpital and the enquiry of the case is being conducted by appropriate authority.
