(a) whether the European Union countries propose to open up custom free access to exports from the 48 least developed countries;

(b) if so, India's exports to these countries during 1999-2000 and 2000-2001; and (

(c) the extent to which the Euro-move is likely to affect India's exports to European Union?

Answer

MINISTER OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRI MURASOLI MARAN)

(a): Yes, Sir. Under their `Everything But Arms` (EBA) proposal, the European Union has opened up duty free access to exports from 48 Least Developed Countries. This initiative is effective from 5/3/2001, with provision for longer transition period in case of sugar, rice and bananas.

(b): India's exports to European Union countries during 1999-2000 and 2000-2001 amounted to US\$ 9,337.41 million and US\$ 10,362.58 million respectively.

(c): The EBA initiative could be an opportunity to Indian trade and industry for setting up of new production capacities and investment opportunities in LDC countries.
