- (a): Amongst the major ports, Kolkata, Haldia, Visakhapatnam, Chennai, Tuticorin, Cochin, Mormugao, Jawaharlal Nehru and Mumbai Ports are handling container ships.
- (b)&(c): No, Sir. However, containers handling facilities need to be modernized and augmented continuously to cater to the increased traffic volumes and various Port Trusts are taking steps in this regard.
