Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether export of wheat has been made during last three years;
- (b) if so, quantum of export, country-wise and year-wise alongwith price in each case;
- (c) whether the Government propose to make available export quality wheat to some States and Union Territories at export price in case when such requests are received; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI CHAUHAN)

- (a): Yes, Sir.
- (b) Information in this respect is being collected and will be laid on the table of the House.
- (c)&(d): The Government is already providing wheat at Rs. 4150/- per MT (same price forexport till 31.3.2001, which has since been enhanced to Rs. 4300/- per MT since April 2001) to BPL population of this country. The Government has also decided to give foodgrains at BPL rates for
- (i) welfare institutions catering to the needs of destitute men, women and children at the rate of 5 kg per head per month and
- (ii) for all welfare schemes of Government of India including `Food for Work` Programme. The Antyodaya Anna Yojana has also been launched which provides wheat to the poorest of the poor families at Rs.2/- per kg.
