- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. BHEL has received an order for supply and providing technical assistancefor installation of 3x123.4 MW Gas Turbine Generating units and the electrical and mechanical auxiliaries, from a subsidiary company of AES, U.S.A. for their project at Stonehaven in Australia.
- (c): The contract is for US dollars 59.4 million (equivalent to Rs.278 cores)
- (d): An exclusive INDIATECH Exhibition is to be organized in March,2002 in Sydney, Australia by the Engineering Export Promotion Council with the support of the Department of Commerce underthe Market Development Assistance Scheme. This is expected to give significant boost to the efforts for increasing export of engineering goods to Australia by providing an opportunity to the participating companies to display their products to the prospective buyers.
