## Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether several exchanges connected by Optical Fibre Cables (OFC) are functioning poorly in Orissa;

(b) if so, the reasons therefor and the steps taken by the Government in this regard;

(c) whether a large number of sanctioned telephone connections are pending due to lack of planning and poor administrative management and scarcity of material in the State;

(d) if so, the details thereof; and

(e) the time by which said connections are likely to be provided?

## Answer

## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI TAPAN SIKDAR)

(a) No, Sir.

(b) Does not arise in view of (a) above.

(c) Pending sanctioned telephone connections are not large. A few sanctioned telephone connections are pending due to technical non-feasibility in rural areas where the demand for connections are scattered and far off from existing exchanges.

(e) Connections to wait listed applicants are likely to be provided by March, 2002.
