- (a) whether the Government have formulated any scheme under National Environment Awareness Campaign for the year 2001-2002;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the amount allocated by the Government, State-wise; and
- (d) the extent of improvement is likely to be brought about in environment through such schemes?

Answer

MINISTER OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI T.R. BAALU)

- (a)&(b) The Government has invited proposals from interested organisations including non-governmental organisations to conduct awareness activities like camps, padyatras, rallies, public meetings, exhibitions, essay/debate/painting/poster competitions, folk dances and songs, street theatre, puppet shows etc. under National Environment Awareness Campaign for the year 2001-2002. These activities would also include an action-oriented component for enhancement of environment quality. The proposals are required to be submitted to the Regional Resource Agencies (RRAs) by 20th August, 2001.
- (c) The proposals would be considered by the Regional Committees and the financial assistance would be allocated on the basis of recommendations of these Committees.
- (d) The activities to be conducted under this Campaign are likely to create environmental awareness amongst general public and to motivate them to take up programmes for improvement of environmental quality.
