The Minimum Needs Programme (MNP) was replaced by the Basic MinimumServices (BMS) Programme in 1996.Planning Commission has allocated Additional Central Assistance (ACA) for BMS to the States and UTs since 1996-97 in order to complement the resources of the States and UTs for the BMS Programme.

However, it has been decided to introduce a new initiative in the form of Pradhan Mantri's Gramoday Yojana (PMGY) in theyear 2000-2001 in order to achieve the objective of sustainable human development at the village level. PMGY will have two components, namely, Rural Roads and Other Programmes of PMGY. The later include Primary Health, Primary Education, Rural Shelter, Rural Drinking Water and Nutrition. An allocation of Rs. 5000 crore as Additional Central Assistance (ACA) has been made for PMGY. Each of the two components would have an allocation of Rs. 2500 crore of ACA. The Ministry of Rural Development will be responsible for the Rural Roads component of the PMGY. In so far as the other components of PMGY is concerned, the ACA for BMS, is being replaced by the ACA for other Programmes of PMGY to begiven to the States and UTs. The State and UT-wise allocation worked out by the Planning Commission is annexed.
