(a) to (e) The price policy for copra for 2000 season is under consideration of the Government. The National Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation Ltd. (NAFED) has been instructed to purchase copra under Price Support Scheme (PSS) at the MSP ate of 1999 until Minimum Support Price for copra for the Current Season isannounced. NAFED has already started procurement operation through state level agencies viz., Kerala Coconut Growers' Federation Ltd.(KERAFED) and Kerala StateCo-op. Marketing Federation Ltd. (MARKETFED) and as on 12.04.2000, a quantity of 120 MTs of copra has been purchased under PSS by NAFED in Kerala. Further procurement is in progress.
