(a) to (c): The power supply position in the State of Orissa during the period April, 2001-July, 2001 was an under:-

There is no energy shortage in Orissa. However, there is a peaking shortage of 6.6%. Eastern Region as a whole is surplus in power and exports power to other regions. Orissa is also supplying 150 MW power to Andhra Pradesh under a bilateral agreement.
